

Bio of Ned Mohan:

Ned Mohan (Fellow-IEEE) joined the University of Minnesota in 1975, where he is Oscar A. Schott Professor of Power Electronic Systems and Morse-Alumni Distinguished Professor. His PhD in Electrical Engineering and Masters in Nuclear Engineering are from UW-Madison. He has written 5 textbooks, one of which is translated into six languages. He has graduated 35 PhDs.
